Stuart Franklin Eriksen, 85, former Texas Department of Public Safety Patrol Trooper, passed away Saturday, February 25, 2012 at his home in Bedford.

Stuart was born January 17, 1927 in St. Paul, Minnesota to the late Gustav Adolf and Ida Christine Eriksen. He moved to Graham at the age of 4. Stuart served during World War II on the USS Grafton from 1944 to 1946 when honorably discharged from the United States Navy.

Stuart joined the Texas Highway Patrol where he proudly served for 34 years until his retirement in 1989.
